Hoopla - Borrow free comics, digital video, music, and audiobooks with your library card. All titles are downloadable.

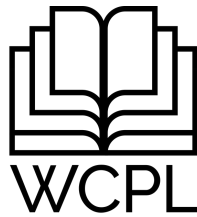

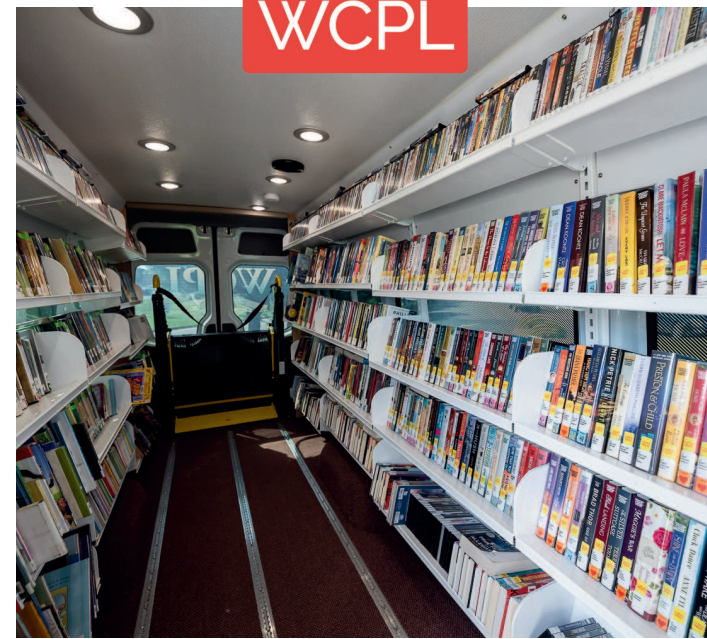
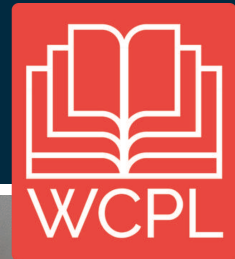
